## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation of firefighters and fire departments by

- 3 the Texas Commission on Fire Protection.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 419, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 419.0323 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 419.0323. RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN CERTIFICATE
- 8 HOLDERS. (a) An employee of a municipality that has adopted
- 9 Chapter 143, Local Government Code, may not perform a duty that is
- 10 classified as a wildland firefighting duty, including conducting a
- 11 prescribed burn, unless that person is a permanent, full-time fire
- 12 department civil service employee regularly assigned to perform one
- or more duties listed under Section 419.021(3)(C), regardless of
- 14 whether the person holds a certificate issued by the commission
- 15 under this chapter.
- 16 (b) This section does not prohibit a municipal employee from
- 17 performing a duty that may be classified as a wildland firefighting
- 18 duty if the municipal employee:
- 19 <u>(1) is not acting as an employee of a municipality when</u>
- 20 performing the duty; and
- 21 (2) is acting as a member of a volunteer fire
- 22 department when performing the duty.
- 23 (c) The commission shall adopt and implement rules relating
- 24 to the application of this section to a fire department.

- 1 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Fire Protection shall
- 2 adopt the rules required under Section 419.0323, Government Code,
- 3 as added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2016.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
