5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 419, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 419.0323 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 419.0323. RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN CERTIFICATE
8	HOLDERS. (a) A person who is a municipal employee may not perform a
9	duty that is classified as a wildland firefighting duty, including
10	conducting a prescribed burn, unless the person is a permanent,
11	full-time fire department employee regularly assigned to perform
12	one or more duties listed under Section 419.021(3)(C), regardless
13	of whether the person holds a certificate issued by the commission
14	under this chapter.
15	(b) This section does not prohibit a municipal employee from
16	performing a duty that may be classified as a wildland firefighting
17	duty if the municipal employee:

- 18 (1) is not acting as an employee of a municipality when
- 19 performing the duty; and
- 20 (2) is acting as a member of a volunteer fire
- 21 <u>department when performing the duty.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 419.909, Government Code, is amended by
- 23 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 24 (d) The commission shall adopt and implement rules relating

- 1 to the application of this section to a fire department.
- 2 SECTION 3. The Texas Commission on Fire Protection shall
- 3 adopt the rules required under Section 419.909, Government Code, as
- 4 amended by this Act, not later than January 1, 2016.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
