- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.064, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A permit application under this subchapter must
- 8 contain:
- 9 <u>(1) a certification from the applicant that the</u>
- 10 applicant has mailed to each resident living one mile or less from
- 11 the site and each community organization, nonprofit organization,
- 12 or civic club located two miles or less from the site:
- (A) an explanation of the site's proposed
- 14 operations; and
- 15 (B) a questionnaire seeking community comments
- 16 regarding the site's proposed operations; and
- 17 (2) any comments made by residents, organizations, or
- 18 <u>clubs in response to the questionnaire.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 20 to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas
- 21 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 22 of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the
- 23 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date
- 24 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the

- 1 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 2 that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
