- 2 Relating to the definition of a "Navigable stream".
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.001 (3), Natural Resources Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 21.001(3). DEFINITIONS. In this chapter,
- 7 (a) "Navigable stream" means a stream or river which retains
- 8 an average width of 30 feet from the mouth up \pm , and which maintains
- 9 a constant water depth of 12 inches or greater.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 11.096, Water Code, is amended to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 (a) No person may obstruct the navigation of any stream a
- 13 navigable stream which can be navigated by steamboats, keelboats,
- 14 or flatboats by cutting and felling trees or by building on or
- 15 across the stream any dike, milldam, bridge, or other obstruction.
- 16 (b) A fence built or maintained for the purpose of the
- 17 containment of livestock shall not be a violation under this
- 18 <u>section</u>.
- 19 SECTION 3: This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 <u>a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as</u>
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
