- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 107.015(c), Family Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) If indigency of the parents is shown, an attorney ad
- 9 litem appointed to represent a child or parent in a suit filed by a
- 10 governmental entity shall be paid from the general funds of the
- 11 county or by the governmental entity that filed the suit in an
- 12 <u>amount</u> according to the fee schedule that applies to an attorney
- 13 appointed to represent a child in a suit under Title 3 as provided
- 14 by Chapter 51. The court may not award attorney ad litem fees under
- 15 this chapter against the state, a state agency, or a political
- 16 subdivision of the state except as provided by this subsection.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
