- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 26, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 26.048 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 26.048. TERM LIMITS IN POPULOUS MUNICIPALITIES. (a)
- 8 This section applies only to a municipality with a population of 1.8
- 9 million or more.
- 10 (b) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Governing body of a municipality" includes the
- 12 presiding officer of the municipality.
- 13 (2) "Municipal term limit" means a provision in a
- 14 municipal charter or ordinance that imposes a limit on the number of
- 15 terms or otherwise restricts the length of service a member of the
- 16 governing body of a municipality may serve on the governing body.
- 17 (c) The presiding officer of a municipality shall order an
- 18 election in the municipality on the first uniform election date in
- 19 November that occurs in an even-numbered year after this section
- 20 becomes applicable to the municipality on the question of imposing
- 21 term limits of a maximum of two four-year terms on the members of
- 22 the governing body of the municipality.
- 23 (d) The ballot at the election must be printed to permit
- 24 voting for or against the proposition: "Authorizing term limits

- 1 consisting of a maximum of two four-year terms on a person's service
- 2 on the governing body of the City of (insert name of municipality)."
- 3 (e) If a majority of the votes received at the election
- 4 favor the proposition, the number and length of terms a person may
- 5 serve on the governing body is limited to a maximum of two four-year
- 6 terms. The municipality shall adjust the length of the terms of the
- 7 members of the governing body as necessary to comply with the
- 8 proposition.
- 9 (f) If less than a majority of the votes received at the
- 10 election favor the proposition, municipal term limits and the
- 11 length of the terms of the members of the governing body that
- 12 existed before the election are not affected.
- 13 (g) In applying a term limit authorized by this section:
- 14 (1) a term to which a member of the governing body was
- 15 <u>elected or appointed before the election held under Subsection (c)</u>
- 16 is counted only if the member served one-half or more of the term;
- 17 and
- 18 (2) a partial term to which a member of the governing
- 19 body is elected or appointed on or after the date of the election
- 20 held under Subsection (c) is counted only if the member serves
- 21 one-half or more of the term.
- (h) This section expires January 1, 2017.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
