5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 2166, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2166.410 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2166.410. ENERGY EFFICIENCY PILOT PROGRAM. (a) The
8	Energy Systems Laboratory at the Texas A&M Engineering Experiment
9	Station, in consultation with the commission and the State Energy
10	Conservation Office, shall establish and implement a pilot program
11	in which:
12	(1) the State Energy Conservation Office makes or
13	guarantees loans used to finance improvements that will increase
14	the energy efficiency of state-owned buildings; and
15	(2) the savings in utility costs resulting from the
16	improvements made under Subdivision (1) generate a 30 percent
17	return on the costs of the improvements.
18	(b) A loan made or guaranteed under this section must have
19	an amortization period twice as long as the projected period in
20	which the loan could be repaid with utility cost savings
21	attributable to the improvements made under this section.
22	(c) Money attributable to utility cost savings resulting
23	from improvements made to a building under the program may be
24	appropriated only to the governmental entity that owns the building

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1 in which the utility cost savings occur.

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(d) This section expires August 31, 2020.

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
