If there is money in the fund after those costs are paid, on approval by the 10 11 employing court, a juvenile case manager may direct the remaining 12 money to be used to implement programs directly related to the duties of the juvenile case manager, including juvenile alcohol and 13 14 substance abuse programs, educational and leadership programs, and any other projects designed to prevent or reduce the number of 15 16 juvenile referrals to the court. The fund may not be used to supplement the income of an employee whose primary role is not that 17

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
