| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. The heading to Section 13.047, Election Code, is |
| 6 | amended to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 13.047. TRAINING STANDARDS FOR DEPUTY REGISTRARS: |
| 8 | TRAINING USING MATERIALS POSTED ON SECRETARY OF STATE WEBSITE. |
| 9 | SECTION 2. Section 13.047, Election Code, is amended by |
| 10 | adding Subsections (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i) to read as |
| 11 | follows: |
| 12 | (c) The secretary of state shall provide on the agency's |
| 13 | website the training materials and, if applicable, the examination |
| 14 | that a potential volunteer deputy registrar may access at any time. |
| 15 | (d) The materials posted online and described by Subsection |
| 16 | (c) must allow an applicant to download and print a document to be |
| 17 | used as a certificate of completion of training. The document must: |
| 18 | (1) provide for the applicant to include the |
| 19 | applicant's name, county, and residence address and any other |
| 20 | information the secretary of state considers necessary; |

- 21 (2) include the examination questions, if required by
- 22 the secretary of state; and
- 23 (3) contain a form on which the applicant may execute an affidavit affirming that the applicant has read the training 24

- 1 materials in their entirety.
- 2 (e) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 3 makes a false statement or requests, commands, or attempts to
- 4 induce another person to make a false statement on an affidavit
- 5 completed as part of a certificate of completion. An offense under
- 6 this subsection is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 7 <u>(f) An applicant who completes the training materials and a</u>
- 8 certificate of completion shall present the certificate to the
- 9 registrar at the time the applicant requests appointment as a
- 10 volunteer deputy registrar. Upon appointment, the applicant is not
- 11 required to take further training and may immediately receive
- 12 another person's voter registration application.
- 13 (g) The registrar must accept a certificate of completion
- 14 presented by an applicant and appoint the person as a volunteer
- 15 <u>deputy registrar if the applicant:</u>
- 16 (1) is eligible to be appointed as a volunteer deputy
- 17 registrar under this subchapter;
- 18 (2) has executed the affidavit with an original
- 19 signature; and
- 20 (3) has passed the examination, if applicable.
- 21 (h) At the time a volunteer deputy registrar who received
- 22 training is appointed, the registrar shall advise the volunteer:
- 23 (1) of county-specific procedures for processing
- 24 voter registration applications, if applicable; and
- 25 (2) that the only requirements for voter registration
- 26 are those prescribed by state law or by the secretary of state.
- 27 (i) A volunteer deputy registrar requesting appointment in

- 1 an additional county may present the person's valid certificate of
- 2 appointment as proof of training. The volunteer is eligible to
- 3 <u>receive</u> another person's voter registration application
- 4 immediately on receiving a certificate of appointment from the
- 5 registrar of the additional county.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
