## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to certain information reported to county voter registrars
- and to the Department of Public Safety and to the cancellation of a 3
- driver's license based on that information. 4

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 16.001(c), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 7
- (c) Once each week, on a day specified by the secretary of 8
- 9 state, the vital statistics unit of the Department of State Health
- <u>Services</u> [Bureau of Vital Statistics] shall furnish to the 10
- 11 secretary of state available information specified by the secretary
- relating to deceased residents of the state. Not later than the 12
- fifth business day after the date the secretary of state receives 13
- 14 the information from the department [Periodically], the secretary
- shall furnish to the appropriate voter registrars information 15
- 16 obtained from the <u>department</u> [bureau] that will assist
- identifying the deceased registered voters of each county. 17
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 411.209 to read as follows: 19
- Sec. 411.209. CANCELLATION ON NOTICE OF DEATH. Not later 20
- 21 than the fifth business day after the date the department receives a
- copy of a person's death certificate under Section 191.030, Health 22
- 23 and Safety Code, the department shall cancel a license issued to the
- person under this subchapter. 24

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- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 191, Health and Safety
- 2 Code, is amended by adding Section 191.030 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 191.030. RECORDS FILED WITH COUNTY AND DEPARTMENT OF
- 4 PUBLIC SAFETY. (a) Not later than the 10th day of each month, the
- 5 local registrar shall file with the commissioners court or the
- 6 county auditor, as appropriate, a copy of each death certificate
- 7 filed with the local registrar during the preceding month.
- 8 (b) Each copy must show the local registrar's file date and
- 9 signature.
- 10 (c) The copies shall be deposited in the county clerk's
- 11 office.
- 12 (d) This section does not apply in a municipality that has
- 13 an ordinance requiring that a copy of each birth, death, and fetal
- 14 death certificate be permanently filed in the office of the
- 15 municipality's registrar.
- (e) Not later than the fifth business day after the date the
- 17 local registrar files a copy of a certificate under Subsection (a),
- 18 the local registrar shall file a copy of each death certificate
- 19 filed with the local registrar during the preceding month with the
- 20 Department of Public Safety.
- 21 SECTION 4. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 22 is amended by adding Section 521.011 to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.011. CANCELLATION ON NOTICE OF DEATH. Not later
- 24 than the fifth business day after the date the department receives a
- 25 copy of a person's death certificate under Section 191.030, Health
- 26 and Safety Code, the department shall cancel a driver's license or
- 27 personal identification certificate issued to the person under this

- 2 SECTION 5. Chapter 521A, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 3 adding Section 521A.002 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 521A.002. CANCELLATION ON NOTICE OF DEATH. Not later
- 5 than the fifth business day after the date the department receives a
- 6 copy of a person's death certificate under Section 191.030, Health
- 7 and Safety Code, the department shall cancel an election
- 8 identification certificate issued to the person under this chapter.
- 9 SECTION 6. Subchapter A, Chapter 522, Transportation Code,
- 10 is amended by adding Section 522.008 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 522.008. CANCELLATION ON NOTICE OF DEATH. Not later
- 12 than the fifth business day after the date the department receives a
- 13 copy of a person's death certificate under Section 191.030, Health
- 14 and Safety Code, the department shall cancel a commercial driver's
- 15 <u>license or commercial driver learner's permit issued to the person</u>
- 16 <u>under this chapter.</u>
- 17 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
