5	SECTION 1. Section 52.072(e), Election Code, is amended to

8	a proposition, including a provision prescribing the proposition
9	language, a proposition submitted to the voters for approval of the
10	issuance of bonds or the imposition, increase, or reduction of a tax
11	shall specifically state, as applicable:
12	(1) with respect to a proposition seeking voter
13	approval of the issuance of bonds:
14	(A) the total principal amount of the bonds to be
15	authorized, if approved; [and]
16	(B) a general description of the purposes for
17	which the bonds are to be authorized, if approved; and
18	(C) if the issuer is a city:
19	(i) the most recent rating, if any, given by
20	Standard and Poor's or another industry-recognized bond rating
21	service to bonds issued by the city; and
22	(ii) a plain-language description of the
23	applicable bond rating system, if a bond rating is required to be
