4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 521.124, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) A temporary license issued to an applicant must include:
8	(1) the applicant's name;
9	(2) the date of issuance of the temporary license;
10	(3) a statement indicating either that the applicant
11	submitted a voter registration application or declined to register
12	to vote; and
13	(4) the following statement: "If you submitted a voter
14	registration application at the time you applied for a driver's
15	license, this temporary license is proof of your application for
16	voter registration. Retain it until you receive a voter
17	registration certificate from your local voter registrar. If you
18	do not receive a voter registration certificate, you may use this as
19	<pre>proof that you submitted a timely voter registration application."</pre>
20	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21	to a temporary license issued by the Department of Public Safety of
22	the State of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. A
23	temporary license issued by the Department of Public Safety of the
24	State of Texas before the effective date of this Act is governed by

- 1 the law in effect at the time of issuance and the former law is
- 2 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
