- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 659.015(i), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (i) With authorization from the administrative head of the
- 8 agency for which an employee works, or that person's designee, an
- 9 employee may be paid an amount based on the employee's regular rate
- 10 of pay for:
- 11 (1) the hours of compensatory time the employee earns
- 12 for work directly related to a disaster or emergency declared by the
- 13 appropriate officer of the state or federal government; or
- 14 (2) all or part of the hours of compensatory time the
- 15 employee earns for work in an information technology position
- 16 requiring skills in high demand in the information technology labor
- 17 market.
- SECTION 2. Section 659.016(i), Government Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (i) Except as provided by this subsection and Subsection
- 21 (j), an employee covered by this section may not be paid for any
- 22 unused compensatory time. With authorization from the
- 23 administrative head of the agency for which a state employee works,
- 24 or that person's designee, an employee may be paid an amount based

- 1 on the employee's regular rate of pay for:
- 2 <u>(1)</u> the hours of compensatory time the employee earns
- 3 for work directly related to a disaster or emergency declared by the
- 4 appropriate officer of the state or federal government; or
- 5 (2) all or part of the hours of compensatory time the
- 6 employee earns for work in an information technology position
- 7 requiring skills in high demand in the information technology labor
- 8 market.
- 9 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 10 compensatory time earned on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
