## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 7.042 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 7.042. INTERNET WEBSITE CLEARINGHOUSE FOR SCHOOL
- 9 DISTRICT INFORMATION. (a) The agency shall develop and maintain an
- 10 Internet website clearinghouse, separate from the agency's
- 11 Internet website, for the public to access school district and
- 12 campus reports, notices, and other information that a school
- 13 <u>district or campus is required by law to publish.</u>
- 14 (b) The agency shall create a web page for each school
- 15 district on the Internet website clearinghouse. Each school
- 16 district may post on the district's web page on the website any
- 17 report, notice, or other information that the district is required
- 18 to publish. Each school district may designate district personnel
- 19 with authority to enter reports, notices, and other information on
- 20 the district's web page.
- 21 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, a school district that
- 22 posts a report, notice, or other information on the district's web
- 23 page on the Internet website clearinghouse created under this
- 24 section that is required by law to be published by a school district

- 1 or campus satisfies that publication requirement if the report,
- 2 notice, or information remains posted for the period as prescribed
- 3 by law.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
