- 3 submitted to the chief appraiser of an appraisal district in an

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 11, Tax Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 11.49 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11.49. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS. (a) In this section,
- 9 "supporting document" means a document required by this code or
- 10 other law to be filed with the chief appraiser to demonstrate a
- 11 person's eligibility for an exemption from ad valorem taxation.
- 12 (b) The chief appraiser may not post on the appraisal
- 13 <u>district's Internet website a supporting document included with an</u>
- 14 application for an exemption filed with the chief appraiser.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
