- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 16.031(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) The registrar shall cancel a voter's registration
- 9 immediately if the registrar:
- 10 (1) determines from information received under
- 11 Section 16.001(c) that the voter is deceased;
- 12 (2) has personal knowledge that the voter is deceased;
- 13 (3) receives from a person related within the second
- 14 degree by consanguinity or affinity, as determined under Chapter
- 15 573, Government Code, to the voter a signed [sworn] statement by
- 16 that person indicating that the voter is deceased; or
- 17 (4) receives notice from the secretary of state under
- 18 Section 18.068 that the voter is deceased.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
