- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (b-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (b-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), (b-1), or any other
- 8 law, and to the extent consistent with federal law, a student in a
- 9 special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, may not
- 10 be administered an assessment instrument if the student's parent or
- 11 a person standing in parental relation to the student has submitted
- 12 to the district or school a written statement indicating that the
- 13 parent or person standing in parental relation to the student
- 14 elects to exempt the student from administration of an assessment
- 15 instrument. The student's admission, review, and dismissal
- 16 committee, in consultation with the student's parent or a person
- 17 standing in parental relation to the student, shall develop an
- 18 individual progress plan for a student exempt from administration
- 19 of an assessment instrument as provided by this subsection. The
- 20 commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to administer this
- 21 <u>subsection</u>.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 23 school year.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
