- SECTION 1. Section 21.047, Property Code, is amended by 5 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: 6
- 7 (a-1) If the amount of damages awarded by the special
- commissioners is at least 10 percent greater than the amount of the 8
- condemnor's initial offer or if the commissioners' award is 9
- appealed and a court awards damages in an amount that is at least 10 10
- percent greater than the amount of the condemnor's initial offer, 11
- the condemnor shall pay: 12

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- 13 (1) all costs as provided by Subsection (a); and
- 14 (2) any reasonable attorney's fees and other
- professional fees incurred by the property owner in connection with 15
- 16 the eminent domain proceeding.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17
- to an eminent domain proceeding commenced on or after the effective 18
- date of this Act. An eminent domain proceeding commenced before the 19
- 20 effective date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the
- proceeding immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 21
- that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 22
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
