- 6 SECTION 1. Section 16.051, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 16.051. RESIDUAL LIMITATIONS PERIOD. Every action for
- 9 which there is no express limitations period, except an action for
- 10 the recovery of real property and an action to enforce a right or
- 11 remedy provided by Section 50(a)(6), Article XVI, Texas
- 12 Constitution, must be brought not later than four years after the
- 13 day the cause of action accrues.
- 14 SECTION 2. The amendment by this Act of Section 16.051,
- 15 Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is intended to clarify rather
- 16 than change existing law. An action to enforce a right or remedy
- 17 provided by Section 50(a)(6), Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 18 not time barred regardless of when the cause of action accrued and
- 19 may be brought on or after the effective date of this Act
- 20 notwithstanding any application of a statute of limitations to an
- 21 action filed before the effective date of this Act asserting the
- 22 same cause of action.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
