4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 140.012 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 140.012. POSTING OF FINANCIAL INFORMATION BY SPECIAL
8	PURPOSE DISTRICT. (a) In this section, "special purpose district"
9	means a political subdivision of this state with boundaries that
10	are not statewide, other than a municipality, county, or
11	independent school district.
12	(b) A special purpose district shall maintain a financial
13	transparency Internet website and shall post to that website:
14	(1) the district's budget for the district's current
15	fiscal year and the three preceding fiscal years;
16	(2) a comprehensive financial report for the
17	district's three preceding fiscal years; and
18	(3) an electronic checking account transaction
19	register with information for the district's current fiscal year
20	and the three preceding fiscal years that meets the requirements of

(c) A special purpose district shall maintain the

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- 1 Subsection (d), the electronic checking account transaction
- 2 register must include for each check written from a district

- 4 (1) the transaction amount;
- 5 (2) the check number;
- 6 (3) the name of the payee; and
- 7 (4) a statement of the purpose of the expenditure for
- 8 which the check was written.
- 9 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a special purpose
- 10 <u>district's electronic checking account transaction register must</u>
- 11 contain the information required by Subsections (c)(1), (2), and
- 12 (3) for each check dated before January 1, 2016. A district's
- 13 electronic checking account transaction register must contain the
- 14 information required by Subsections (c)(1) through (4) for each
- 15 check dated on or after January 1, 2016. This subsection expires
- 16 <u>December 31, 2019.</u>
- 17 (d) A special <u>purpose district</u> may not include in the
- 18 district's electronic checking account transaction register a
- 19 check issued to a district employee in payment of a workers'
- 20 compensation income benefit, medical benefit, death benefit, or
- 21 burial benefit that is issued by a special purpose district
- 22 operating as a self-insurer under Chapter 504, Labor Code.
- (e) A special purpose district shall update the electronic
- 24 checking account transaction register at least once each month, not
- 25 later than the 90th day after the closing date of the most recent
- 26 monthly statement for the checking account.
- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
