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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 62, Health and Safety Code, is amended by 7 adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

## 8 SUBCHAPTER E. CHIP PERINATAL PROGRAM

- 9 <u>Sec. 62.201. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "postpartum</u>
  10 <u>depression" means a disorder with postpartum onset that is</u>
  11 <u>categorized as a mood disorder by the American Psychiatric</u>
  12 <u>Association in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental</u>
  13 <u>Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), or a subsequent edition adopted by</u>
- rule by the executive commissioner of the commission.
- 15 Sec. 62.202. COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN SERVICES REQUIRED. (a)
- 16 The covered services under the CHIP perinatal program must include,
- 17 for each woman who gives birth to a child who is enrolled in the CHIP
- 18 perinatal program before birth, screening and treatment for
- 19 postpartum depression for the 12-month period after the date the
- 20 woman gives birth to the child.
- 21 (b) The coverage for postpartum depression provided under
- 22 Subsection (a):
- 23 (1) must provide mental health services to a woman
- 24 regardless of whether the woman has been found to be a danger to

- 1 herself or others; and
- 2 (2) may not place an arbitrary or artificial limit on
- 3 the amount of services that may be provided.
- 4 (c) The executive commissioner of the commission shall
- 5 adopt rules necessary to implement this section.
- 6 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 7 is amended by adding Section 32.0249 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 32.0249. SERVICES RELATED TO POSTPARTUM DEPRESSION.
- 9 (a) For purposes of this section, "postpartum depression" means a
- 10 disorder with postpartum onset that is categorized as a mood
- 11 disorder by the American Psychiatric Association in the Diagnostic
- 12 and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, 5th Edition (DSM-5), or
- 13 a subsequent edition adopted by rule by the executive commissioner
- 14 of the Health and Human Services Commission.
- 15 (b) The department shall provide to a woman who receives
- 16 medical assistance benefits during a pregnancy screening and
- 17 treatment for postpartum depression for the 12-month period after
- 18 the date the woman gives birth.
- 19 (c) The department shall provide mental health services to a
- 20 woman under Subsection (b) regardless of whether the woman has been
- 21 found to be a danger to herself or others.
- 22 <u>(d) The department may not place an arbitrary or artificial</u>
- 23 limit on the amount of services that may be provided under
- 24 Subsection (b).
- 25 (e) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 26 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement this
- 27 section.

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- 1 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 2 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 3 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 5 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 6 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
