- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 8849, Special District Local Laws Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Sec. 8849.107 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8849.107. Permits Issued for Historic Use. (a) In
- 8 promulgating any rules limiting groundwater production, the
- 9 district shall preserve historic use to the maximum extent
- 10 practicable consistent with the district's management plan.
- 11 (b) The historic use period shall begin January 1, 2001 and
- 12 end December 31, 2012, and the district shall issue historic use
- 13 permits for permitted use during that historic use period.
- 14 (c) Historic use permits shall be issued in an amount equal
- 15 to the maximum amount of groundwater actually withdrawn and placed
- 16 to a beneficial use without waste during any one calendar year
- 17 during the historic use period.

- 18 <u>(d) The district may impose more restrictive permit</u>
- 19 conditions on new permit applications and permit amendment
- 20 <u>applications to increase use by historic users if the limitations:</u>
- 21 (1) apply to all subsequent new permit applications
- 22 and permit amendment applications to increase use by historic
- 23 users, regardless of type or location of use;
- 24 (2) bear a reasonable relationship to the approved

- 1 district management plan; and
- 2 (3) are reasonably necessary to protect existing use.
- 3 (e) Historic use permits may form the basis of an operating
- 4 permit but do not relieve the permittee from district regulations
- 5 regarding beneficial use, conservation, waste or regulatory
- 6 pumping fees, or any other district rules.
- 7 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 8 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 9 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 10 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 11 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on September 1, 2015.
