Section 36.060, Water Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 7 (e) For liability purposes only, a director is considered a 8 district employee under Chapter 101, Civil Practice and Remedies 9 Code, even if the director does not receive fees of office 10 voluntarily, by district policy, or through a statutory exception 11 12 to this section. SECTION 2. Section 36.066(a), Water Code, is amended to 13

13 SECTION 2. Section 36.066(a), water code, is amended to 14 read as follows:

(a) A district may sue and be sued in the courts of this state in the name of the district by and through its board. <u>A</u> <u>district board member is immune from suit and immune from liability</u> <u>for official votes and official actions.</u> All courts shall take judicial notice of the creation of the district and of its boundaries.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
