A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to providing for endorsements for public high school
- 3 students enrolled in special education programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c-7) to read as follows:
- 7 (c-7) A student who is enrolled in a special education
- 8 program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, or who is covered by Section
- 9 504, Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794), may earn an
- 10 endorsement on the student's diploma or transcript by successfully
- 11 completing the requirements for that endorsement adopted by the
- 12 State Board of Education by rule with or without modification of the
- 13 curriculum. As applicable, the school district may indicate on the
- 14 diploma or transcript that the student is enrolled in a special
- 15 education program or is covered by Section 504, Rehabilitation Act
- 16 of 1973 (29 U.S.C. Section 794).
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
