## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of the Public Utility Commission of Texas

3 to approve certain payments by municipally owned utilities for

- 4 transmission facilities in lieu of ad valorem taxes.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.051, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (g), Payments in Lieu of Ad Valorem, to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (g) A municipally owned utility that is required to apply
- 10 for a certificate of convenience and necessity for a transmission
- 11 <u>facility may agree with the governing body of a taxing entity with</u>
- 12 authority to assess ad valorem taxes on the transmission facility
- 13 to make payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes on the transmission
- 14 facility. A municipally owned utility that agrees to make payments
- 15 in lieu of ad valorem taxes under this section shall recover, as
- 16 part of its transmission cost of service, the reasonable amount
- 17 paid to a taxing entity under the agreement to the extent that those
- 18 payments are the amount the municipally owned utility would have to
- 19 pay on that transmission facility if the facility were subject to ad
- 20 valorem taxation. A municipally owned utility that agrees to make
- 21 payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes under this section shall
- 22 provide a copy of the agreement to the commission.
- 23 SECTION 2. This section applies to a transmission line to be
- 24 constructed after the effective date of this act.
