

1 AN ACT

2 relating to training requirements for peace officers appointed to
3 supervisory positions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1701.352(d), Occupations Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (d) A peace officer who is appointed or will be appointed to
8 the officer's first supervisory position must receive in-service
9 training on supervision as part of the course provided for the
10 officer under Subsection (b) not earlier than the 12th month before
11 the date of that appointment or later than the first anniversary of
12 ~~[during the 24-month period after]~~ the date of that appointment.

13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
14 to an appointment made on or after the effective date of this Act.
15 An appointment made before the effective date of this Act is
16 governed by the law in effect on the date the appointment was made,
17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
