- 6 Session, 2007, is amended by adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as

- 8 (3-a) "Qualified retired law enforcement officer" has
- 9 the meaning assigned by 18 U.S.C. Section 926C.
- 10 SECTION 2. Subchapter H, Chapter 614, Government Code, as
- 11 added by Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature,
- 12 Regular Session, 2007, is amended by adding Section 614.1241 to

- 14 Sec. 614.1241. QUALIFIED RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.
- 15 (a) On request of a qualified retired law enforcement officer who
- 16 holds a certificate of proficiency under Section 1701.357,
- 17 Occupations Code, the law enforcement agency or other governmental
- 18 entity in this state that was the last entity to appoint or employ
- 19 the qualified retired law enforcement officer as a peace officer
- 20 shall issue an identification card to the qualified retired law

- 22 (b) The identification card must include:
- 23 (1) the full name of the qualified retired law
- 24 enforcement officer;

- 4 (3) the name of the law enforcement agency or other

- 7 (4) if applicable, the signature of the person
- 8 authorizing the issuance of the card on behalf of the law
- 9 enforcement agency or other governmental entity to the qualified

- 11 (5) a brief description of the qualified retired law
- 12 enforcement officer, including the qualified retired law
- 13 enforcement officer's height, weight, and eye color;
- 14 (6) the thumbprint of the qualified retired law
- 15 enforcement officer or a bar code with a unique identification
- 16 <u>label for the qualified retired law enforcement officer;</u>
- 17 (7) the date the qualified retired law enforcement
- 18 officer last served as a peace officer for the law enforcement
- 19 agency or other governmental entity;
- 20 (8) the date the law enforcement agency or other
- 21 governmental entity issued the card to the qualified retired law
- 22 enforcement officer; and
- 23 (9) a phone number operational 24 hours a day, seven

If an identification 13 14 card issued under this subchapter is lost or stolen, the law 15 enforcement agency or other governmental entity that issued [issuing] the card to the peace officer, reserve law enforcement 16 17 officer, honorably retired peace officer, or qualified retired law enforcement officer shall issue a duplicate identification card to 18 19 the officer if the [may: 20 [(1) require a peace officer, reserve law enforcement 21 officer, or honorably retired peace] officer submits [to submit] an affidavit executed by the [peace officer, reserve law enforcement 22 officer, or honorably retired peace] officer to the law enforcement 23 24 agency or other governmental entity [issuing the card] stating that the identification card was lost or stolen[; and 25 26 [(2) issue a duplicate identification card to
