(a) On 15 16 request of a qualified retired law enforcement officer who holds a certificate of proficiency under Section 1701.357, Occupations 17 Code, the law enforcement agency or other governmental entity in 18 this state that was the last entity to appoint or employ the 19 qualified retired law enforcement officer as a peace officer shall 20 issue an identification card to the qualified retired law 21 enforcement officer. 22 23 (b) The identification card must include: 24 (1) the full name of the qualified retired law
