- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.0523 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 81.0523. POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY. (a) A
- 9 political subdivision may adopt or enforce an order, ordinance, or
- 10 similar measure that applies to a person or operation over whom or
- 11 which the commission has jurisdiction under this title only as
- 12 provided by this section.
- 13 <u>(b) The commission has exclusive jurisdiction to determine</u>
- 14 whether the adoption or enforcement by a political subdivision of
- 15 an order, ordinance, or similar measure applies to a person or
- 16 operation over whom or which the commission has jurisdiction under
- 17 this title.
- (c) A political subdivision shall petition the commission
- 19 for permission before adopting or enforcing an ordinance, order, or
- 20 <u>similar measure described by Subsection (a).</u>
- 21 (d) The commission may grant a petition only if the
- 22 political subdivision offers proof satisfactory to the commission
- 23 that the ordinance, order, or similar measure is reasonable and
- 24 enhances public safety.

- 1 (e) This section does not apply to an ordinance, order, or
- 2 similar measure described by Subsection (a) that is authorized by a
- 3 state agency other than the commission.
- 4 (f) A provision of this title that affirms the authority of
- 5 or grants authority to a political subdivision to regulate a person
- 6 or operation over whom or which the commission has jurisdiction
- 7 under this title does not exempt the political subdivision from
- 8 complying with this section.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 121.053 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 121.053. POLITICAL SUBDIVISION AUTHORITY. (a) A
- 12 political subdivision may adopt or enforce an order, ordinance, or
- 13 similar measure that applies to any aspect or phase of the gas
- 14 pipeline industry only as provided by this section.
- 15 <u>(b) The railroad commission has exclusive jurisdiction to</u>
- 16 determine whether the adoption or enforcement by a political
- 17 subdivision of an order, ordinance, or similar measure applies to
- 18 any aspect or phase of the gas pipeline industry.
- 19 (c) A political subdivision shall petition the railroad
- 20 commission for permission before adopting or enforcing an
- 21 ordinance, order, or similar measure described by Subsection (a).
- 22 (d) The railroad commission may grant a petition only if the
- 23 political subdivision offers proof satisfactory to the railroad
- 24 commission that the ordinance, order, or similar measure is

- 8 SECTION 4. Sections 81.0523, Natural Resources Code, and
- 9 121.053, Utilities Code, as added by this Act, apply to an
- 10 ordinance, order, or similar measure adopted by a political
- 11 subdivision before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
