A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to disclosures and transfer expenses for transfers of
- 3 structured settlement payments.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 141.003, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 141.003. REQUIRED DISCLOSURES TO PAYEE. At least $\underline{10}$
- 8 [three] days before the date on which the payee signs a transfer
- 9 agreement, the transferee shall provide to the payee a separate
- 10 disclosure statement, in bold type at least 14 points in size, that
- 11 states in plain language:
- 12 (1) the amounts and due dates of the structured
- 13 settlement payments to be transferred;
- 14 (2) the aggregate amount of the payments;
- 15 (3) the discounted present value of the payments to be
- 16 transferred, which shall be identified as the "calculation of
- 17 current value of the transferred structured settlement payments
- 18 under federal standards for valuing annuities," and the amount of
- 19 the Applicable Federal Rate used in calculating the discounted
- 20 present value;
- 21 (4) the gross advance amount;
- 22 (5) an itemized listing of all applicable transfer
- 23 expenses, other than attorney's fees and related disbursements
- 24 payable in connection with the transferee's application for

- 1 approval of the transfer, and the transferee's best estimate of the
- 2 amount of those expenses;
- 3 (6) the net advance amount;
- 4 (7) the amount of any penalties or liquidated damages
- 5 payable by the payee in the event of any breach of the transfer
- 6 agreement by the payee; [and]
- 7 (8) [a statement] that the payee has the right to
- 8 cancel the transfer agreement, without penalty or further
- 9 obligation, not later than the third business day after the date the
- 10 agreement is signed by the payee; and
- 11 (9) that the payee is advised to seek independent
- 12 legal and financial advice before entering into the transaction and
- 13 that the transferee will reimburse the payee up to \$1,500 for the
- 14 costs incurred in obtaining that advice.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 16 is amended by adding Section 141.0035 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 141.0035. MAXIMUM TRANSFER EXPENSES; REIMBURSEMENT OF
- 18 CERTAIN PAYEE COSTS. (a) A transferee may not charge a payee
- 19 transfer expenses in excess of six percent of the aggregate amount
- 20 of the structured settlement payments due to the payee. The
- 21 <u>limitation described by this subsection excludes reasonable</u>
- 22 attorney's fees, taxes incurred by the transferee as a result of the
- 23 transfer, and any other liabilities or costs arising from obtaining
- 24 approval of the transfer under this chapter.
- 25 (b) The transferee shall reimburse the payee up to \$1,500 of
- 26 the payee's costs to obtain independent legal and financial advice
- 27 with respect to the transfer agreement before the agreement is

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- 1 entered into. The transferee may not refer the payee to an attorney
- 2 <u>or financial advisor.</u>
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
