- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 5, Subchapter L, Water Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 5.5146, as follows:
- Sec. 5.5146. EMERGENCY ORDER CONCERNING OPERATION OF 8
- CERTAIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES WITHOUT PERMIT. 9
- (a) The commission may issue an emergency order under this 10
- <u>subchapter</u> <u>suspending</u> <u>operations</u> <u>of</u> a domestic wastewater 11
- 12 treatment facility that is required to obtain a permit from the
- commission and is operating without the required permit. 13
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 7, Subchapter B, Water Code, is amended
- by adding Section 7.035, as follows: 15
- Sec. 7.035. CORRECTIVE ACTION RELATING 16 TO CERTAIN
- WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES. 17
- 18 (a) Except as provided in Subsection (b), if the commission
- determines that a domestic wastewater treatment facility that is 19
- required to obtain a permit from the commission is operating 20
- 21 without the required permit, the commission shall:
- 22 (1) issue an order enjoining further operation of the
- 23 facility until the commission has issued a permit authorizing the
- operation and imposing an administrative penalty pursuant to 24

1 Section 7.052(c); or

- 2 (2) institute a civil action under Subchapter D to
- 3 enjoin further operation of the facility until the commission has
- 4 issued a permit authorizing the operation and to impose a civil
- 5 penalty;
- 6 (b) The commission may initiate alternative enforcement
- 7 action under this Chapter if the commission determines there is no
- 8 <u>feasible alternative treatment or disposal option for the waste</u>
- 9 stream being sent to the facility, including the option of hauling
- 10 the waste stream to a permitted facility.
- 11 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 12 a violation that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 13 A violation that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 14 governed by the law in effect on the date the violation occurred,
- 15 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
