	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of a deer management program commission.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 63, Texas Parks and Wildlife Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 63.003, to read as follows:
6	Section 63.003. DEER MANAGEMENT COMMISSION. (a) In this
7	section:
8	(1) "Commission" means the deer management
9	<pre>commission;</pre>
10	(2) "Deer" means a white-tailed deer or mule deer;
11	(3) "Department" means the Parks and Wildlife
12	Department.
13	(b) The commission is composed of the following nineteen
14	members:
15	(1) two veterinarians who are members of the Texas
16	Deer Association, one whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the
17	house of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the
18	lieutenant governor;
19	(2) two wildlife biologists who are members of the
20	Texas Deer Association, one whom shall be appointed by the speaker
21	of the house of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by
22	the lieutenant governor;
23	(3) two veterinarians who are members of the Texas
24	Wildlife Association, one whom shall be appointed by the speaker of

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1 the house of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the 2 lieutenant governor; 3 (3) two wildlife biologists who are members of the Texas Wildlife Association, one whom shall be appointed by the 4 5 speaker of the house of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the lieutenant governor; 6 7 (4) two representatives from the Texas Parks and 8 Wildlife Department; 9 (4) two representatives from the Texas Animal Health 10 Commission; (5) two representatives from Texas A&M University, one 11 12 whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the lieutenant 13 14 governor; 15 (6) two representatives of Texas A&M University -Kingsville, one whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house 16 17 of representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the 18 lieutenant governor; 19 (7) two representatives of Texas Tech University, one whom shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of 20 representatives and one whom shall be appointed by the lieutenant 21 22 governor; and (8) the governor shall appoint a member of the public 23 24 who has demonstrated a high knowledge of deer management to serve as the chair of the commission. The chair may not be a member of the 25 26 Texas Deer Association or the Texas Wildlife Association. (c) The commission shall study and make recommendations 27

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1	regarding deer management practices for both white-tailed and mule
2	deer, including:
3	(1) study and determine exact pharmaceutical
4	withdrawal periods;
5	(2) study and develop guidelines for the denial and
6	review of deer breeder permits;
7	(3) study and recommend practices for the
8	identification of breeder deer;
9	(4) study and recommend practices for captivity of
10	breeder deer;
11	(5) study and recommend practices for the transfer of
12	breeder deer;
13	(6) study and recommend practices for the sale of game
14	<pre>meat;</pre>
15	(7) study and recommend practices for the trapping of
16	deer;
17	(8) recommend guidelines for the notification and
18	appeal process regarding the depopulation of some or all of a deer
19	breeder's herd; and
20	(9) recommend a date for the release of breeder deer
21	prior to an open hunting season.
22	(d) A commission member is not entitled to compensation for
23	the services provided as a commission member. A commission member
24	may receive reimbursement for the member's actual and necessary
25	expenses incurred in performing commission duties.
26	(e) The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and the Texas
27	Animal Health Commission shall use existing resources to conduct

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1	the study.
2	(f) The commission may solicit and accept donations from
3	private and public sources for the purpose of this section.
4	(g) The commission shall meet at the call of the presiding
5	officer and may hold additional meetings by telephone conference
6	call if necessary.
7	(h) The commission shall hold at least three public hearings
8	in locations selected by the commission to provide interested
9	persons an opportunity to appear and speak on any subject relating
10	to the powers and duties of the commission.
11	(i) Not later than January 1, 2017, the commission shall
12	provide the department, the legislature, and the governor, a final
13	report on deer management recommendations.
14	(j) Not later than January 1, 2019, the commission shall
15	provide the department, the legislature, and the governor, a final
16	report on the implementation of deer management practices.
17	(k) This Section expires and the commission is abolished on
18	June 1, 2019.
19	(1) Not later than December 1, 2015, the governor shall
20	appoint the chair of the commission, the speaker of the house of
21	representatives, and the lieutenant governor shall appoint the
22	members of the commission created under this section.
23	(m) The commission is subject to Chapters 551 and 552,
24	Government Code.
25	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
26	immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
27	elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas

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Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
