- 2 relating to contributions and registrations for an anatomical gift
- 3 registry; authorizing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 502.405, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.405. <u>VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO DONOR REGISTRY</u>
- 8 [EDUCATION, AWARENESS, AND REGISTRY PROGRAM].
- 9 SECTION 2. Sections 502.405(a) and (b), Transportation
- 10 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (a) The department shall provide to each county
- 12 assessor-collector the educational materials for prospective
- 13 donors provided under Section 502.189 [as required by the Donor
- 14 Education, Awareness, and Registry Program of Texas under Chapter
- 15 49, Health and Safety Code. The educational materials shall be
- 16 made available in each office authorized to accept applications for
- 17 registration of motor vehicles].
- 18 (b) When a person applies for the registration or renewal of
- 19 registration of a motor vehicle, the person may elect to contribute
- 20 \$1 or more to the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda
- 21 Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry established under Chapter 692A,
- 22 Health and Safety Code. The department shall remit any
- 23 contribution paid under this subsection to the comptroller for
- 24 deposit to the credit of the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas

- 1 Registry fund created under Section 692A.020, Health and Safety
- 2 Code. Money received under this subsection by the organization may
- 3 be used only for the purposes described by Section 692A.020(i),
- 4 Health and Safety Code [to manage the organization's registry,
- 5 provide donor education, and promote donor awareness]. The
- 6 organization shall submit an annual report to the legislature and
- 7 the comptroller that includes the total dollar amount of money
- 8 received by the organization under this subsection. If a person
- 9 makes a contribution under this section and does not pay the full
- 10 amount of the registration fee, the department may credit all or a
- 11 portion of the contribution to the person's registration fee. The
- 12 department shall:
- 13 (1) include space on each motor vehicle registration
- 14 renewal notice, on the page that states the total fee for
- 15 registration renewal, that allows a person renewing a registration
- 16 to voluntarily contribute \$1 or more to the organization;
- 17 (2) provide an opportunity for a person to contribute
- 18 \$1 or more to the organization during the registration renewal
- 19 process on the department's Internet website; and
- 20 (3) provide an opportunity to contribute \$1 or more to
- 21 the organization in any registration renewal system that succeeds
- 22 the registration renewal system in place on September 1, 2015
- 23 [2013].
- SECTION 3. Section 521.008(a), Transportation Code, as
- 25 added by Chapter 121 (S.B. 1815), Acts of the 83rd Legislature,
- 26 Regular Session, 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal

- 1 driver's license under this chapter, the person may contribute \$1
- 2 or more to the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda
- 3 Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry under Chapter 692A, Health and
- 4 Safety Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 521.126, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsections (b) and (i) and adding Subsection (n) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsections (d), (e), (e-1), (g),
- 9 (i), [and] (j), and (n), and Section 501.101, Business & Commerce
- 10 Code, a person commits an offense if the person:
- 11 (1) accesses or uses electronically readable
- 12 information derived from a driver's license, commercial driver's
- 13 license, or personal identification certificate; or
- 14 (2) compiles or maintains a database of electronically
- 15 readable information derived from driver's licenses, commercial
- 16 driver's licenses, or personal identification certificates.
- 17 (i) The prohibition provided by Subsection (b) does not
- 18 apply to a health care provider or hospital that accesses, uses,
- 19 compiles, or maintains a database of the information to provide
- 20 health care services to the individual who holds the driver's
- 21 license, commercial driver's license, or personal identification
- 22 certificate. If an individual objects to the collection of
- 23 information under this subsection, the health care provider or
- 24 hospital must use an alternative method to collect the individual's
- 25 information.
- 26 (n) The prohibition provided by Subsection (b) does not
- 27 apply to the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda Dawson

- 1 Donate Life-Texas Registry under Section 692A.020, Health and
- 2 Safety Code, or an organ procurement organization, tissue bank, or
- 3 eye bank, as those terms are defined by Section 692A.002, Health and
- 4 Safety Code, for the purpose of scanning the individual's
- 5 information on the individual's driver's license, commercial
- 6 driver's license, or personal identification certificate to
- 7 register the individual as an anatomical gift donor. Before
- 8 transmitting information scanned under this subsection, the
- 9 nonprofit organization, organ procurement organization, tissue
- 10 bank, or eye bank shall:
- 11 (1) notify the individual of the registry's purpose
- 12 and the purposes for which the information will be used;
- 13 (2) require the individual to verify the accuracy of
- 14 the information; and
- 15 (3) require the individual to affirm consent to make
- 16 <u>an anatomical gift through the individual's use of the individual's</u>
- 17 electronic signature.
- 18 SECTION 5. Section 521.422(c), Transportation Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- (c) When a person applies for the issuance or renewal of a
- 21 personal identification card, including a duplicate personal
- 22 identification card or a personal identification card issued or
- 23 renewed over the Internet or by other electronic means, the person
- 24 may elect to contribute \$1 or more to the nonprofit organization
- 25 administering the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry
- 26 established under Chapter 692A, Health and Safety Code. The
- 27 department shall remit any contribution paid under this subsection

- 1 to the comptroller for deposit to the credit of the Glenda Dawson
- 2 Donate Life-Texas Registry fund created under Section 692A.020,
- 3 Health and Safety Code. Before sending the money to the
- 4 comptroller, the department may deduct money equal to the amount of
- 5 reasonable expenses for administering this subsection, not to
- 6 exceed five percent of the money collected under this
- 7 subsection. The organization shall submit an annual report to the
- 8 director of the department that includes the total dollar amount of
- 9 money received by the organization under this subsection.
- SECTION 6. Section 522.021, Transportation Code, is amended
- 11 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 12 (e) When the department issues a license to which this
- 13 section applies, the department shall provide the person to whom
- 14 the license is issued with written information about the Glenda
- 15 Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry operated under Chapter 692A,
- 16 <u>Health and Safety Code</u>.
- 17 SECTION 7. Chapter 522, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subchapter J to read as follows:
- 19 SUBCHAPTER J. ANATOMICAL GIFTS
- Sec. 522.151. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "registry"
- 21 means the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry established
- 22 under Section 692A.020, Health and Safety Code.
- Sec. 522.152. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO DONOR REGISTRY.
- 24 (a) When an individual applies for an original or renewal
- 25 commercial driver's license under this chapter, the individual may
- 26 contribute \$1 or more to the nonprofit organization administering
- 27 the registry.

- 1 (b) The department shall:
- 2 (1) include space on each application for a new or
- 3 renewal commercial driver's license that allows an individual
- 4 applying for a new or renewal commercial driver's license to
- 5 indicate that the individual is voluntarily contributing \$1 or more
- 6 to the organization; and
- 7 (2) provide an opportunity for the individual to
- 8 contribute \$1 or more to the organization during the application
- 9 process for a new or renewal commercial driver's license on the
- 10 department's Internet website.
- 11 (c) The department shall remit any contribution made under
- 12 this section to the comptroller for deposit to the credit of the
- 13 Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry fund created under Section
- 14 692A.020, Health and Safety Code. Before sending the money to the
- 15 comptroller, the department may deduct an amount, not to exceed
- 16 five percent of the money collected under this section, for the
- 17 reasonable expenses incurred by the department in administering
- 18 this section.
- 19 (d) The organization shall submit an annual report to the
- 20 director of the department that includes the total dollar amount of
- 21 contributions received by the organization under this section.
- Sec. 522.153. STATEMENT OF GIFT; PROVISION OF REGISTRY
- 23 INFORMATION. (a) An individual who wishes to be an organ, tissue,
- 24 or eye donor may execute a statement of gift.
- 25 (b) The statement of gift may be shown on a donor's
- 26 commercial driver's license or by a card designed to be carried by
- 27 the donor to evidence the donor's consent with respect to organ,

- 1 tissue, and eye donation. A donor card signed by the donor shall be
- 2 given effect as if executed under Section 692A.005, Health and
- 3 Safety Code.
- 4 (c) The donor registry or organ procurement organizations,
- 5 tissue banks, or eye banks, as those terms are defined by Section
- 6 692A.002, Health and Safety Code, shall provide donor registry
- 7 information to the department and the Texas Department of
- 8 Transportation. The department, with expert input and support
- 9 from the nonprofit organization administering the registry, shall:
- 10 (1) provide to each applicant for the issuance of an
- 11 original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate commercial driver's
- 12 license who applies in person, by mail, over the Internet, or by
- 13 other electronic means:
- 14 (A) the opportunity to indicate on the person's
- 15 commercial driver's license or personal identification certificate
- 16 that the person is willing to make an anatomical gift, in the event
- 17 of death, in accordance with Section 692A.005, Health and Safety
- 18 Code; and
- 19 (B) an opportunity for the individual to consent
- 20 to inclusion in the registry and release to procurement
- 21 organizations in the manner provided by Subsection (d); and
- 22 (2) provide a means to distribute registry information
- 23 to interested individuals in each office authorized to issue
- 24 commercial driver's licenses.
- 25 (d) The department shall:
- 26 (1) specifically ask each applicant only the question,
- 27 "Would you like to register as an organ donor?"; and

- 1 (2) if the applicant responds affirmatively to the
- 2 question asked under Subdivision (1), provide the individual's
- 3 name, date of birth, commercial driver's license number, most
- 4 recent address, and other information needed for identification
- 5 purposes at the time of donation to the nonprofit organization
- 6 contracted to maintain the registry for inclusion in the registry.
- 7 <u>(e) An affirmative statement of gift on an individual's</u>
- 8 commercial driver's license executed after August 31, 2015, shall
- 9 be conclusive evidence of a decedent's status as a donor and serve
- 10 as consent for organ, tissue, and eye removal.
- 11 (f) The department shall distribute at all field offices
- 12 Donate Life brochures that provide basic donation information in
- 13 English and Spanish and include a contact phone number and e-mail
- 14 address. The department shall include the question required under
- 15 Subsection (d)(1) and information on the donor registry Internet
- 16 website in renewal notices.
- 17 Sec. 522.154. REVOCATION OF STATEMENT OF GIFT. (a) To
- 18 revoke an affirmative statement of gift on an individual's
- 19 commercial driver's license, the individual must apply to the
- 20 department for an amendment to the license.
- 21 (b) The fee for an amendment is the same as the fee for a
- 22 duplicate license.
- (c) To have an individual's name removed from the registry,
- 24 the individual must provide written <u>notice to the nonprofit</u>
- 25 organization selected under Chapter 692A, Health and Safety Code,
- 26 to maintain the registry directing the removal of the individual's
- 27 name from the registry. On receipt of a written notice under this

- 1 subsection, the organization shall promptly remove the
- 2 <u>individual's name and information from the registry.</u>
- 3 SECTION 8. Section 521.126(k), Transportation Code, is
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect January 1, 2016.
