- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is 6
- 7 amended by adding Section 1551.227 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1551.227. TRICARE MILITARY HEALTH SYSTEM SUPPLEMENTAL 8
- 9 PLAN. (a) The board of trustees shall make available a TRICARE
- Military Health System supplemental plan to an employee or 10
- annuitant who waives coverage under the basic coverage plan under 11
- 12 Section 1551.1045 and is eligible for benefits under the TRICARE
- Military Health System. The board of trustees may not contribute to 13
- 14 the cost of the supplemental plan, including the premium cost.
- (b) A plan offered under this section must be considered a 15
- permissible offering to TRICARE participants and beneficiaries 16
- under 10 U.S.C. Section 1097c. 17
- (c) The board of trustees may adopt rules necessary to 18
- implement this section, including rules regarding eligibility for 19
- the plan, available insurance products, and enrollment in the plan. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2.4
