## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the scoring criteria for an application for a low income
- 3 housing tax credit.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.6725(d), Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) For each scoring criterion, the department shall use a
- 8 range of points to evaluate the degree to which a proposed project
- 9 satisfies the criterion. The department may not award:
- 10  $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  a number of points for a scoring criterion that is
- 11 disproportionate to the degree to which a proposed project complies
- 12 with that criterion; or
- 13 (2) to a proposed project for the general population a
- 14 number of points for a scoring criterion that is different than the
- 15 number of points awarded for that criterion to a proposed project
- 16 exclusively for elderly persons if the proposed projects comply
- 17 with the criterion to the same degree.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to an application for low income housing tax credits that is
- 20 submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs
- 21 during an application cycle that begins on or after the effective
- 22 date of this Act. An application that is submitted during an
- 23 application cycle that began before the effective date of this Act
- 24 is governed by the law in effect at the time the application cycle

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- 1 began, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
