- 10 [COMMITTEE]. (a) The presiding officer of the commission, with the
- 11 commission's approval, may appoint a <u>combative sports</u> [<u>medical</u>]
- 12 advisory board [committee] to advise the department concerning
- 13 [health] issues relating to [for] combative sports events and
- 14 [event] contestants.
- 15 (b) If the commission elects to appoint an advisory board
- 16 [committee], the commission by rule shall establish:
- 17 (1) the number of <u>board</u> [committee] members;
- 18 (2) qualifications for appointment to the <u>board</u>
- 19 [committee]; and
- 20 (3) the purpose and duties of the <u>board</u> [committee].
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
