- Sec. 2052.055. COMBATIVE SPORTS [MEDICAL] ADVISORY BOARD 9 [COMMITTEE]. (a) The presiding officer of the commission, with the 10 commission's approval, may appoint a combative sports [medical] 11 12 advisory **board** [committee] to advise the department concerning [health] issues relating to [for] combative sports events and 13
- 14 [event] contestants.
- (b) If the commission elects to appoint an advisory board 15 [committee], the commission by rule shall establish: 16
- 17 (1) the number of <a href="mailto:board">board</a> [committee] members;
- 18 (2) qualifications for appointment to the <u>board</u> [committee]; and 19
- (3) the purpose and duties of the <u>board</u> [committee]. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
