Section 622.902, Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 622.902. LENGTH EXCEPTIONS. The length limitations 8 9 provided by Sections 621.203 to 621.205 do not apply to: machinery used exclusively for drilling water 10 (1) wells, including machinery that is itself a unit or that is a unit 11 12 mounted on a conventional vehicle or chassis; 13 (2) a vehicle owned or operated by a public, private, 14 or volunteer fire department; (3) a vehicle or combination of vehicles operated 15 16 exclusively in the territory of a municipality or to a combination of vehicles operated by a municipality in a suburb adjoining the 17 municipality in which the municipality has been using the equipment 18 or similar equipment in connection with an established service to 19 20 the suburb; 21 (4) a truck-tractor, truck-tractor combination, or truck-trailer combination exclusively transporting machinery, 22 23 materials, and equipment used in the construction, operation, and maintenance of facilities, including pipelines, that are used for 24

1 the discovery, production, and processing of natural gas or petroleum; 2 3 (5) а drive-away saddlemount vehicle transporter combination or a drive-away saddlemount with fullmount vehicle 4 5 transporter combination, as defined by 23 C.F.R. Part 658 or its successor, if: 6 7 (A) the overall length of the combination is not 8 longer than 97 feet; and the combination does not have more than three 9 (B)

10 saddlemounted vehicles if the combination does not include more
11 than one fullmount vehicle;

12 (6) the combination of a tow truck and another vehicle13 or vehicle combination if:

(A) the other vehicle or vehicle combination
cannot be normally or safely driven or was abandoned on a highway;
and

(B) the tow truck is towing the other vehicle or
vehicle combination directly to the nearest authorized place of
repair, terminal, or destination of unloading; or

20 (7) a vehicle or combination of vehicles used to 21 transport a combine <u>harvest machine</u> that is used in farm custom 22 harvesting operations on a farm if the overall length of the vehicle 23 or combination is not longer than:

(A) 75 feet if the vehicle is traveling on a
highway that is part of the national system of interstate and
defense highways or the federal aid primary highway system; or
(B) 81-1/2 feet of truck-tractor, semitrailer,

and trailer combination, excluding the length of the towing device,
if the vehicle is not traveling on a highway that is part of the
national system of interstate and defense highways or the federal
aid primary highway system.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
