5	SECTION 1. Sections 551.053(a) and (c), Government Code,

10	(1) post notice of each meeting at a place convenient
11	to the public in the administrative office of the district or
12	political subdivision;
13	(2) provide notice of each meeting to the secretary of

15	(3) <u>either</u> provide notice of each meeting to the
16	county clerk of the county in which the administrative office of the
17	district or political subdivision is located or post notice of each
18	meeting on the district's or political subdivision's Internet
19	website.
20	(c) A county clerk shall post <u>a</u> [the] notice provided <u>to the</u>
21	\underline{clerk} under Subsection (a)(3) on a bulletin board at a place
22	convenient to the public in the county courthouse.
23	SECTION 2. Section 551.054, Government Code, is amended to
24	read as follows:

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Sec. 551.054. DISTRICT OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION EXTENDING
INTO FEWER THAN FOUR COUNTIES: NOTICE TO PUBLIC AND COUNTY CLERKS;
PLACE OF POSTING NOTICE. (a) The governing body of a water
district or other district or political subdivision that extends
into fewer than four counties shall:

6 (1) post notice of each meeting at a place convenient 7 to the public in the administrative office of the district or 8 political subdivision; and

9 (2) <u>either</u> provide notice of each meeting to the 10 county clerk of each county in which the district or political 11 subdivision is located <u>or post notice of each meeting on the</u> 12 <u>district's or political subdivision's Internet website</u>.

13 (b) A county clerk shall post <u>a</u> [the] notice provided <u>to the</u> 14 <u>clerk</u> under Subsection (a)(2) on a bulletin board at a place 15 convenient to the public in the county courthouse.

16 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to notice for a meeting held on or after the effective date of this 18 Act. Notice for a meeting held before the effective date of this Act 19 is governed by the law in effect on the date the notice is given, and 20 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
