- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission
- 6 shall conduct a study on the benefits of providing integrated care
- 7 to veterans with post-traumatic stress disorder. To conduct the
- 8 study, the Health and Human Services Commission may coordinate with
- 9 a university and medical school with expertise in behavioral health
- 10 or post-traumatic stress disorder. The study must evaluate the
- 11 benefits of:
- 12 (1) using a standardized comprehensive trauma and
- 13 post-traumatic stress disorder assessment to identify and target
- 14 evidence-based treatment services to provide integrated care for
- 15 veterans diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder; and
- 16 (2) involving family members in the treatment of a
- 17 veteran diagnosed with post-traumatic stress disorder.
- 18 (b) Not later than December 1, 2016, the Health and Human
- 19 Services Commission shall submit a report containing the results of
- 20 the study conducted under Subsection (a) of this section to the
- 21 governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of
- 22 representatives. The report must include the number of people
- 23 served and the type of integrated care provided through the study.
- SECTION 2. This Act expires September 1, 2017.
