1	AN ACT
2	relating to a general permit to convey water using the bed and banks
3	of a natural stream channel; authorizing a fee.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 11.0425 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.0425. GENERAL PERMIT TO CONVEY WATER USING NATURAL
8	STREAM CHANNELS. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Developed water" means groundwater, surface
10	water, desalinated water, or other water that would not naturally
11	be found in the natural stream channel used to convey the water.
12	The term does not include water imported from a source located in
13	the United Mexican States, unless the water is covered by a treaty
14	between the United States of America and the United Mexican States
15	or a related minute order.
16	(2) "Natural stream channel" means the bed and banks
17	of a river, natural stream, or watercourse in this state, including
18	a lake, reservoir, or impoundment located along the river, stream,
19	or watercourse.
20	(b) The commission may issue a general permit to authorize a
21	person to use a natural stream channel to convey developed water for

use in this state.

(1) may:

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(c) A general permit issued under this section:

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1	(A) include conditions based on the
2	characteristics of different sources of developed water or natural
3	stream channels; and
4	(B) either:
5	(i) provide for commencement of conveyance
6	of developed water through a natural stream channel on the filing of
7	a complete and accurate notice of intent to operate under the
8	general permit; or
9	(ii) specify a period or date following
10	receipt of the complete and accurate notice of intent to operate
11	under the general permit for commencement of conveyance of
12	developed water through a natural stream channel, on the condition
13	that the executive director has not notified the person that the
14	person is not authorized under the general permit before the 61st
15	day after the date the notice of intent is received;
16	(2) may not unduly discriminate between similarly
17	situated sources of developed water or natural stream channels; and
18	(3) must:
19	(A) specify a deadline and required information
20	for submitting a notice of intent to use the permit; and
21	(B) include conditions that:
22	(i) allow for the diversion of only the
23	amount of developed water conveyed by the natural stream channel,
24	less carriage losses due to seepage, evaporation, and transpiration
25	of aquatic or riparian vegetation;
26	(ii) protect existing water rights,
27	including a right under a permit, certified filing, or certificate

- 1 of adjudication, related to the affected section of the natural
- 2 stream channel;
- 3 (iii) prevent unreasonable effects on fish,
- 4 wildlife, instream beneficial uses, and freshwater inflows to bays
- 5 and estuaries;
- 6 <u>(iv) require the development and</u>
- 7 implementation of an accounting plan to ensure compliance with the
- 8 permit;
- 9 (v) prevent significant impact to the
- 10 quality of water in the natural stream channel used to convey the
- 11 developed water;
- 12 (vi) protect existing uses of water; and
- 13 <u>(vii)</u> promote the efficient use of water.
- (d) Conditions adopted under Subsection (c)(3)(B)(vi) or
- 15 (vii) may not allow for the developed water to cause a degradation
- 16 <u>in the water quality of the affected natural stream channel segment</u>
- 17 to the extent that the water quality classification of the natural
- 18 stream channel segment would be lowered.
- 19 (e) The commission shall publish notice and provide for
- 20 public comment on a proposed general permit in the manner described
- 21 <u>by Section 26.040.</u>
- 22 <u>(f) The commission shall adopt rules to provide for a</u>
- 23 consolidated permit proceeding for a single applicant for both an
- 24 authorization under Chapter 26 and the use of a general permit under
- 25 this section.
- 26 (g) The commission may issue a general permit under this
- 27 section for a term not to exceed 30 years. After notice and comment

- 1 as provided by Section 26.040, a general permit may be amended,
- 2 revoked, or canceled by the commission or renewed by the commission
- 3 for an additional term not to exceed 30 years each. A general permit
- 4 remains in effect until amended, revoked, or canceled by the
- 5 commission or, unless renewed by the commission, until expired. If
- 6 the commission proposes to renew an unexpired general permit, that
- 7 general permit remains in effect until the date on which the
- 8 commission takes final action on the proposed renewal.
- 9 (h) The commission, through a renewal or amendment process
- 10 for a general permit, may add or delete permit requirements or
- 11 limitations. The commission shall provide a reasonable time to
- 12 allow a person covered by the general permit to make the changes
- 13 necessary to comply with the additional requirements.
- 14 (i) A person intending to convey developed water in a
- 15 natural stream channel must file written notice to the commission
- 16 of intent to use a general permit issued under this section, in
- 17 accordance with the general permit or rules adopted by the
- 18 commission.
- 19 (j) The commission, after hearing, shall deny or suspend a
- 20 person's authority to convey developed water under a general permit
- 21 if the commission determines that the person's compliance history
- 22 is classified as unsatisfactory according to commission standards
- 23 under Sections 5.753 and 5.754 and rules adopted and procedures
- 24 developed under those sections. A hearing under this subsection is
- 25 <u>not subject to Chapter 2001, Government Code.</u>
- 26 (k) Developed water conveyed under a general permit issued
- 27 under this section is not subject to appropriation.

- 1 (1) The commission shall include developed water conveyed
- 2 under a permit issued under this section in the water availability
- 3 model for the river basin in which the natural stream channel is
- 4 located as subject to the ownership of the person acting under the
- 5 permit.
- 6 (m) The commission may impose a reasonable and necessary fee
- 7 on a person covered by a general permit.
- 8 <u>(n) The issuance, amendment, renewal, suspension,</u>
- 9 revocation, or cancellation of a general permit or of authority to
- 10 convey developed water under a general permit is not subject to
- 11 Subchapters C-F, Chapter 2001, Government Code.
- 12 (o) This section does not grant any person the right to
- 13 store water in a lake, reservoir, or other impoundment without the
- 14 permission of the owner of the lake, reservoir, or other
- 15 <u>impoundment.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 11.0425, Water Code, as added by this
- 17 Act, applies only to a conveyance of water made on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act. A conveyance of water made before that
- 19 date is governed by the law in effect on the date the conveyance was
- 20 made, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. (a) As soon as practicable, the Texas Commission
- 22 on Environmental Quality shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 23 11.0425, Water Code, as added by this Act.
- 24 (b) A person may not convey water as described by Section
- 25 11.0425, Water Code, as added by this Act, until rules adopted under
- 26 Subsection (a) of this section take effect.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
