4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 28.025, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (c-7) and (c-8) to read as follows:
7	(c-7) Subject to Subsection (c-8), a student who is enrolled
8	in a special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, may
9	earn an endorsement on the student's diploma and transcript by:
10	(1) successfully completing, with or without
11	modification of the curriculum:
12	(A) the curriculum requirements identified by
13	the State Board of Education under Subsection (a); and
14	(B) the additional endorsement curriculum
15	requirements prescribed by the State Board of Education under
16	Subsection (c-2); and
17	(2) successfully completing, with or without
18	modification of the curriculum, all curriculum requirements for
19	that endorsement adopted by the State Board of Education if the
20	courses are part of a coherent sequence of coursework that lead to a
21	nationally or internationally recognized business or industry
22	certification or license.
23	(c-8) For purposes of Subsection (c-7), the admission,
24	review, and dismissal committee of a student in a special education

1	program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, shall determine whether the
2	student is required to achieve satisfactory performance on an
3	end-of-course assessment instrument to earn an endorsement on the
4	student's diploma and transcript.
5	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
6	school year.
7	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
8	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
9	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
10	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

11 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
