A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the jurisdiction of the supreme court and the court of
 3 criminal appeals.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 22.1025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 22.1025. CONSTITUTIONAL RULINGS.
- 8 (a) Any ruling by the court of criminal appeals that any
- 9 statute, rule, or procedure violates either the state or federal
- 10 constitutions shall not be final and shall have no effect until the
- 11 later of:

- 12 (1) 60 days following the ruling; or
- 13 (2) The denial or dismissal of a petition filed in the
- 14 supreme court pursuant to Section 22.002(f) of the Government Code.
- 15 (b) This section is adopted pursuant to the legislative
- 16 authority found in Article V, Section 5(a) of the Texas
- 17 Constitution, among other sources of authority.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 22.002, Government Code, is amended by
- 19 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 20 (f) Whenever the court of criminal appeals determines that a
- 21 statute, rule, or procedure is unconstitutional, the supreme
- 22 court, on the petition of the attorney general or a district or
- 23 county attorney, has original civil jurisdiction to issue writs of
- 24 quo warranto and mandamus to correct any error in the court of

- 1 <u>criminal appeals' determination.</u>
- 2 (1) The jurisdiction granted by this section applies
- 3 no matter whether the court of criminal appeals rules under the
- 4 state constitution, federal constitution, or both.
- 5 (2) The jurisdiction granted by this section applies
- 6 no matter whether the constitutional ruling by the court of
- 7 <u>criminal appeals is characterized as criminal or civil.</u>
- 8 (3) The jurisdiction granted by this section applies
- 9 no matter whether the constitutional ruling by the court of
- 10 <u>criminal appeals is characterized as final or non-final.</u>
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act applies to any decision by the court of
- 12 criminal appeals on or after September 1, 2015.
