A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to application requirements for low income housing tax 3 credits.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 2306.67071(a) and (c), Government Code, 6 are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) Before submitting to the department an application for 8 housing tax credits<u>, including housing tax credits</u> for developments 9 financed through the private activity bond program, including 10 private activity bonds issued by the department, the Texas State 11 Affordable Housing Corporation, or a local issuer, an applicant 12 must provide notice of the intent to file the application to:

13 (1) the governing body of a municipality in which the 14 proposed development site is to be located;

(2) subject to Subdivision (3), the commissioners court of a county in which the proposed development site is to be located, if the proposed site is to be located in an area of a county that is not part of a municipality; or

19 (3) the commissioners court of a county in which the 20 proposed development site is to be located and the governing body of 21 the applicable municipality, if the proposed site is to be located 22 in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality.

(c) The board may not approve an application for housing tax
 credits, including housing tax credits for developments financed

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1 through the private activity bond program, unless the applicant has
2 submitted to the department a certified copy of a resolution from
3 each applicable governing body described by Subsection (a). The
4 resolution must certify that:

5 (1) notice has been provided to each governing body as
6 required by Subsection (a);

7 (2) each governing body has had sufficient opportunity
8 to obtain a response from the applicant regarding any questions or
9 concerns about the proposed development;

10 (3) each governing body has held a hearing under11 Subsection (b); and

12 (4) after due consideration of the information 13 provided by the applicant and public comment, the governing body 14 does not object to the proposed application.

15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an application for low income housing tax credits that is 16 17 submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs during an application cycle that begins on or after the effective 18 date of this Act. An application that is submitted during an 19 application cycle that began before the effective date of this Act 20 is governed by the law in effect at the time the application cycle 21 began, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
