5	SECTION 1. Section 11.0581(a), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) An election for trustees of an independent school
8	district shall be held on the same date as[+
9	[(1) the election for the members of the governing body
10	of a municipality located in the school district;
11	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ the general election for state and county
12	officers <u>or the date of the general primary election</u> [+
13	[(3) the election for the members of the governing body
14	of a hospital district, if the school district:
15	[(A) is wholly or partly located in a county with
16	a population of less than 40,000 that is adjacent to a county with a
17	population of more than three million; and
18	[(B) held its election for trustees jointly with
19	the election for the members of the governing body of the hospital
20	district before May 2007; or
21	[(4) the election for the members of the governing
22	board of a public junior college district in which the school
23	district is wholly or partly located].
24	SECTION 2. Sections 11.059(a) and (e), Education Code, are

1 amended to read as follows:

2 (a) A trustee of an independent school district serves a
3 term of [three or] four years.

4 Not later than December 31, 2015 [2011], the board of (e) 5 trustees may adopt a resolution changing the length of the terms of its trustees. The resolution must provide for staggered terms of 6 [either three or] four years and specify the manner in which the 7 8 transition from the length of the former term to the modified term is made. The transition must begin with the first regular election 9 10 for trustees that occurs after January 1, 2016 [2012], and a trustee who serves on that date shall serve the remainder of that 11 12 term. This subsection expires January 1, 2021 [2017].

13 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 41.0052, Election Code, 14 is amended to read as follows:

15 Sec. 41.0052. [CHANGING] GENERAL ELECTION DATE OF POLITICAL
 16 SUBDIVISION OTHER THAN COUNTY.

17 SECTION 4. Sections 41.0052(a) and (e), Election Code, are 18 amended to read as follows:

(a) The governing body of a political subdivision, other than a county, that holds its general election for officers on a date other than the November uniform election date <u>or the date of</u> <u>the general primary election shall</u> [may], not later than December 31, <u>2016</u> [2012], change the date on which it holds its general election for officers to the November uniform election date <u>or the</u> <u>date of the general primary election</u>.

(e) The governing body of a newly incorporated city may, notlater than the second anniversary of the date of incorporation,

change the date on which it holds its general election for officers
 to another authorized [uniform] election date.

3 SECTION 5. Section 11.059(b), Education Code, and Section 4 41.005, Election Code, are repealed.

5 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
