Subtitle B, Title 10, Government Code, is amended by adding Chapter 2062 to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 2062. STATE AGENCY COLLECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF 7 8 INFORMATION ON INDIVIDUALS 9 Sec. 2062.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "state agency" means a department, commission, board, office, council, authority, 10 or other agency in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch 11 of state government, including a university system or institution 12 of higher education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, 13 that is created by the constitution or a statute of this state. 14 Sec. 2062.002. COLLECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF UNAUTHORIZED 15 INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION PROHIBITED; DESTRUCTION REQUIRED. (a) A 16 state agency may not collect or maintain in any form information 17 that alone or in conjunction with other information identifies an 18 19 individual unless the agency has specific statutory authority for the collection or maintenance of the information. 20 21 (b) A state agency shall destroy or arrange for the destruction of all information that alone or in conjunction with 22 23 other information identifies an individual and that was collected or is maintained by the agency without specific statutory authority 24

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1	or with specific statutory authority that no longer applies.
2	(c) A state agency shall destroy or arrange for the
3	destruction of information described by Subsection (b) by:
4	(1) shredding;
5	(2) erasing; or
6	(3) otherwise modifying the sensitive information in
7	the records to make the information unreadable or indecipherable
8	through any means.
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 2062, Government Code, as added by this
10	Act, applies to information that is collected by a state agency
11	before, on, or after the effective date of this Act or is maintained
12	by a state agency on or after the effective date of this Act.
13	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.

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
