## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to participation in and rates for coverage provided under
- 3 the uniform group coverage program for active employees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. INTERIM COMMITTEE; STUDY. (a) A joint interim
- 6 committee on TRS ActiveCare is established to study:
- 7 (1) the impact of allowing school districts and other
- 8 participating entities in the uniform group coverage program for
- 9 active employees under Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, to opt out of
- 10 that program;
- 11 (2) the impact, should participating entities be
- 12 authorized to opt out of the program, of allowing or prohibiting
- 13 future participation by previous participating entities that have
- 14 opted out; and
- 15 (3) the impact of establishing a regional rating
- 16 method for determining premiums charged in different regions of the
- 17 state for the benefits provided under a group coverage plan
- 18 established under the program.
- 19 (b) The joint interim committee shall be composed of six
- 20 senators appointed by the lieutenant governor and six members of
- 21 the house of representatives appointed by the speaker of the house
- 22 of representatives.
- 23 (c) The lieutenant governor and speaker of the house of
- 24 representatives shall each designate a co-chair from among the

- 1 joint interim committee members.
- 2 (d) The joint interim committee shall convene at the joint
- 3 call of the co-chairs.
- 4 (e) The joint interim committee has all other powers and
- 5 duties provided to a special or select committee by the rules of the
- 6 senate and house of representatives, by Subchapter B, Chapter 301,
- 7 Government Code, and by policies of the senate and house committees
- 8 on administration.
- 9 (f) Not later than January 1, 2017, the joint interim
- 10 committee shall report the committee's findings and
- 11 recommendations to the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 12 house of representatives, the governor, the Teacher Retirement
- 13 System of Texas, and each house and senate standing committee with
- 14 primary jurisdiction over primary and secondary education or health
- 15 benefit plan coverage.
- 16 (g) From the contingent expense fund of the senate and the
- 17 contingent expense fund of the house of representatives equally,
- 18 the members of the joint interim committee shall be reimbursed for
- 19 expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this Act in
- 20 accordance with the senate and house of representatives rules of
- 21 procedure and the policies of the committees on administration.
- 22 Other necessary expenses of operation shall be paid from the
- 23 contingent expense fund of the senate and the contingent expense
- 24 fund of the house of representatives equally.
- 25 SECTION 2. ABOLITION OF COMMITTEE. The joint interim
- 26 committee on TRS ActiveCare created by this Act is abolished and
- 27 this Act expires September 1, 2017.

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- 1 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 2 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 3 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 4 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 5 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
