## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the sale of Beer and Wine on Sunday.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 5 amended by altering Section 105.04 and 105.05 to read as follows:

6 Sec. 105.04. HOURS OF SALE: WINE AND BEER RETAILER. The 7 hours of sale and delivery for alcoholic beverages sold under a wine 8 and beer retailer's permit or a wine and beer retailer's off-premise 9 permit are the same as those prescribed for the sale of beer under 10 Section 105.05 of this code, except that no sale shall be allowed 11 between 2 a.m. and noon 9:00 a.ma. on Sunday.

Sec. 105.05. HOURS OF SALE: BEER. (a) No person may sell, offer for sale, or deliver beer at any time not permitted by this section.

(b) A person may sell, offer for sale, or deliver beer between 7 a.m. and midnight on any day except Sunday. On Sunday he may sell beer between midnight and 1:00 a.m. and between noon and midnight, except that permittees or licensees authorized to sell for on-premise consumption may sell beer between 10:00 a.m. and noon if the beer is served to a customer during the service of food to the customer.

(c) In a city or county having a population of 800,000 or more, according to the last preceding federal census, or 500,000 or more, according to the 22nd Decennial Census of the United States,

1 as released by the Bureau of the Census on March 12, 2001, a holder 2 of a retail dealer's on-premise late hours license may also sell, 3 offer for sale, and deliver beer between midnight and 2 a.m. on any 4 day.

5 (d) In a city or county other than a city or county described 6 by Subsection (c), the extended hours prescribed in Subsection (c) 7 of this section, or any part of the extended hours prescribed in 8 Subsection (c) of this section are effective for the sale, offer to 9 sell, and delivery of beer by a holder of a retail dealer's 10 on-premise late hours license:

(1) in the unincorporated areas of the county if the extended hours are adopted by an order of the commissioners court; and

14 (2) in an incorporated city or town if the extended hours 15 are adopted by an ordinance of the governing body of the city or 16 town.

(e) A violation of a city ordinance or order of a
commissioners court adopted pursuant to Subsection (d) of this
section is a violation of this code.

20 SECTION 2. The Act take effect September 1, 2015.
