5	SECTION 1. Section 572.023, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read
7	as follows:
8	(a) A financial statement must include an account of the
9	financial activity <u>for the preceding calendar year</u> of <u>:</u>
10	(1) any property characterized as separate property
11	under Section 3.001, Family Code, of the individual required by
12	this subchapter to file a financial statement <u>;</u>
13	(2) any community property of which the individual
14	required by this subchapter to file a financial statement has sole
15	management, control, and disposition as provided by Section
16	3.102(a), Family Code;
17	(3) any community property of the individual required
18	by this subchapter to file a financial statement, if the individual
19	exercised both factual and legal control over the activity; and
20	(4) [an account of the financial activity of] the
21	individual's [spouse and] dependent children if the individual
22	exercised or held the right to exercise any degree of legal or
23	<u>factual</u> [had actual] control over that activity [for the preceding
24	calendar year].

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H.B. No. 3511 (g) A person who electronically files a verified financial 1 statement with the commission or another filing authority is not 2 required to include a notarized affidavit with the financial 3 statement if the person: 4 5 (1) has requested and received an electronic filing password pursuant to the rules of the commission or other 6 7 authority, as applicable; and 8 (2) uses that password to file the financial 9 statement. 10 (h) Each financial statement filed under this chapter that is not filed electronically must be accompanied by an affidavit 11 12 executed by the person required to file the financial statement. The affidavit must contain the statement: "I swear, or affirm, 13 14 under penalty of perjury, that the accompanying report is true and 15 correct and includes all information required to be reported by me under Chapter 572, Government Code." Each financial statement filed 16 17 electronically under this chapter must be under oath by the person required to file the financial statement and must contain, in 18 compliance with commission or local filing 19 authority specifications, the digitized signature of the person required to 20 file the financial statement. A financial statement filed under 21 this chapter is considered to be under oath by the person required 22 to file the financial statement, and the person is subject to 23 24 prosecution under Chapter 37, Penal Code, regardless of the absence of or a defect in the affidavit. 25

26 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a financial statement 27 due on or after the effective date of this Act. A financial

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1 statement due before the effective date of this Act is governed by 2 the law in effect on the date the financial statement was due, and 3 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

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4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
