7 [(4)] communicate as a member of an advisory committee

13 SECTION 2. Sections 305.022(c-1) and (c-3), Government 14 Code, are repealed.

15 SECTION 3. A person who is required to register under 16 Chapter 305, Government Code, solely as a result of the change in 17 law made by this Act to Section 305.0041(a), Government Code, is not 18 required to register under that chapter before January 1, 2016.

19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
